Rules and Conditions

The Guinness World Record Firewalking attempt 2012 is being undertaken by The Eastbourne Scout Group in conjunction with Paardekooper and Associates.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Participants take part at their own risk.

Participants must be 14 year of age and over. Any person taking part that is 14 year to 17 years old must have their parents / guardians consent.

The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry to individuals they deem to be not capable of safely completing the attempt.

Participants must obey instructions of event officials.

You are responsible for your own safety at all times.

Neither the organisers, sponsors, Greater Wellington Regional Council, Hutt City Council, nor any party associated with the event shall have any responsibility to participants or their associates for loss or injury which may occur as part of this event.

The organisers reserve the right to use your name, photograph, voice and any written feedback provided by you without payment in any capacity relating to this event.

No refunds will be made for cancellations advised 21 days or less before the fire walking event. If cancellation is requested prior to this, the registration fee less a \$20 administration fee will be refunded.

In the event of extreme weather conditions, the event will be held on the following day. In this case the entry fee will not be refunded. If the event is cancelled entirely, the organisers will make the maximum refund possible to participants. Any refund in this circumstance is at the discretion of the organisers.
